#### **Assessment**

I would like you to be aware of the following:

- The course offers an overview on Sociological topics like culture, communication, inequality, immigration, gender, educational achievement and more. See attachment.
- Class teaching is delivered in-person.
- Attendance is mandatory. Only three absences are permitted.
- Assessment: Submission of an essay that has been selected after consultation with the course lecturers. The essay\* needs to be submitted during the exam period which normally takes place at the end of June.

\*To successfully complete the course students are required to write an essay related to one of the lecture topics. In this respect, during the period of lectures and before the Spring break, the students need to contact, via e-mail the lecturer / tutor, whose lecture topic corresponds to his or her interests.

In this way, students will be allocated to their respective tutor, who will guide them through the specific requirements for the completion of the essay (exact title, number of words, etc.).

The lecturer / tutor will supervise the essay, as well as assess it. The essay needs to be submitted during the exam period which normally takes place at the end of June. The exact dates will be announced by the supervising lecturer / tutor.

Please note: ONLY the lecturers who have provided their emails in the lecture schedule are available to supervise an essay. Please choose among them. *See the attachment*.
