

Sociology of Education II 754

The course deals with approaches in sociology of education that focus on different aspects of schooling. More particularly, the course examines the sociological literature on important subjects, such as the educational aims, the relation of students to teachers, gender and education, intercultural education, racism, and the changing contemporary social role of education.

The course aims at strengthening the analytical and conceptual tools developed in the course of "Sociology of Education I" so that students are able to recognise the sociological approaches to examining the influences of other social institutions on education and vice versa.
