

### **Criminological Contribution of International Organizations (765) / V. Vlachou**

International Organizations' role and especially the contribution of Council of Europe in Criminology is the basic approach of the course. Specifically the topics that analyzed are the following:

1. The Council of Europe and its basic field of activity with emphasis to the protection of human rights.
2. The services that are provided in the above basic field of activity: in the field of criminal law, the field of sentence, the criminological approach and the anticrime policy.
3. The Criminological Conferences and Symposiums from 1963 until today and
4. The role of the Council of Europe in the following fields: a. nations' cooperation, b. criminal law level, c. in the administration of penology and d. anticrime policy.

During the course, some of the topics of the Criminological Conferences and Symposiums are analyzed in order students become familiar with the way that International Organizations and especially Council of Europe face criminal matters and understand their practices.
